RE: Modifications to UII Agreement

A memo was sent to all UIIA participants on March 5, 2026, advising that that Intermodal Interchange Executive Committee (IIEC) had approved proposed modifications to the UIIA. A summary of the proposed revisions are shown below:

- **Section VIII. Compliance with the Agreement, Items C.(3) and C.(5):** The proposed revision to Section VIII.C.(3) is to streamline the process for taking the appropriate action to cancel the UIIA participation of a Party allegedly in violation of the Agreement if that Party does not respond to IANA’s notice within the established timeframe by either refuting or correcting the violation. The Party’s UIIA participation would be cancelled after three business days’ notice following the date the timeframe for response has expired.

The proposed revision to Section VIII.C.(5) is to address repeat offenders of non-compliance under Section VIII. of the UIIA. If a Party’s UIIA participation has been cancelled more than once under Section VIII. Compliance with the Agreement within a 12-month period, reinstatement will require a unanimous vote of all ten voting members of the Intermodal Interchange Executive Committee (IIEC). In addition, the administrative fee for reinstatement will be higher based on the number of times the Party has been reported as non-compliant under Section VIII.

For your convenience, the revisions to the above sections are shown on the following pages. In accordance with Appendix I, Section V. of the Agreement, all UIIA participants were provided with a thirty-day comment period on the proposed revisions. Those comments submitted were forwarded to the IIEC for review and consideration in determining whether to move forward with the proposed modifications. Upon review of the comments submitted on the proposed revisions, the Committee determined that no specific concerns were identified with the proposed revisions to the above sections in the UIIA. Consequently, the Committee voted unanimously to move forward with the modifications as adopted at the February 25<sup>th</sup> IIEC meeting. **The effective date of the revisions will be May 5, 2026.** A full copy of the revised UIIA, which includes the above revisions is available at <https://intermodal.org/uiia/>. **Revisions to the UIIA  
Effective May 5, 2026**

**Revisions noted in “red”/deletions with strikethroughs – all changes highlighted**

To follow are the revisions to **Section VIII. Compliance with the Agreement (Items VIII.C.(3) and VIII.C.(5))**:

**Section VIII. Compliance with the Agreement, Item VIII.C.(3)**

*After the expiration of the time period in Section C.2, IANA shall provide to the Committee all information received by the two involved Parties. **If the Party allegedly in violation of the Agreement fails to respond to IANA’s request, that Party’s participation in the Agreement shall be automatically cancelled effective three (3) business days after the expiration of the time period identified in Section C.2. Otherwise, t**The Committee shall evaluate whether a violation of the Agreement has occurred. If a violation has occurred, the Committee may cancel a Party’s participation in the Agreement upon a three-fourths vote of the entire Committee.*

**Section VIII. Compliance with the Agreement, Item C(5)**

*Upon the request of a cancelled Party, the Committee will review the request and consider reinstatement of the Party as a participant to the UIIA upon a three-fourths vote of the entire Committee and subject to payment of an administrative fee as decided by IANA **except that if a Party has already had its participation cancelled in the past twelve (12) months, that Party may only be reinstated upon a unanimous vote of the entire Committee.***
