RE: Proposed Modification to UII Agreement

In accordance with Appendix I, Section V, of the UIIA, all participants are hereby noticed of a proposed modification approved by the Intermodal Interchange Executive Committee (IIEC) during its meeting held on May 3, 2022. The proposed revision is to further clarify that nothing in Section E.1. of the UIIA precludes a Motor Carrier from being compensated or receiving additional free time when requested by the EP to return equipment to a satellite location. The proposed language is to ensure that all UIIA participants follow the standard industry practice in these situations where both parties are willing to have a reasonable discussion on whether additional compensation or free time is warranted based on the specific circumstances surrounding the return of the equipment to a satellite location.

Below is the proposed revision to Section E.1.e. as approved by the IIEC at its May 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting:

**Section E.1. Equipment Return, Item E.1.e.** (Note: Revisions noted in red and highlighted)

*When the Provider requests the Motor Carrier to return Equipment to a satellite location, the Parties are required to have a reasonable discussion regarding whether additional compensation or free time will be extended to the Motor Carrier. Nothing in Section E shall be interpreted to preclude Motor Carrier from receiving compensation when Provider directs Equipment to be returned to a satellite location. The specific terms of the compensation for services rendered or additional free time in these circumstances is outside the scope of this Agreement and shall be determined between the Motor Carrier and the Provider.*
